The ideal candidate will be a dynamic leader with a strong commitment to animal welfare, community outreach, and education.

The primary responsibility of the Community Engagement Manager will be to facilitate the Fredericksburg SPCA's engagement throughout the community. Additionally, this position will develop growth strategies for the programs it oversees, collect and utilize data for decision making purposes, provide oversight and guidance in developing and managing program budget and project plans, and develop metrics to measure success.

Key Responsibilities Include:

Humane Education Program

- Manage the organization's Humane Education Coordinator.
- Provide oversight and guidance in developing and managing program budget and project plans.
- Manage the collection and utilization of data for decision making purposes.
- Develop metrics to measure success
- Develop growth strategies to expand the reach of the Humane Education program.
- Provide assistance to the Humane Education Coordinator in recruiting, training, and managing educators to support the various educational programming needs of the organization.

• Engage local behavior specialists to provide behavior resources to the public including but not limited to resource guides and videos, training classes, workshops, and one-on-one consultations with trainers for pet owners.

- Work with local businesses to promote fundraising opportunities including payroll deduction programs, sponsorships, and employee engagement programs.
- Build and maintain relationships with schools, local organizations, and individual donors to encourage and facilitate their support of the Fredericksburg SPCA through donations and collaborative initiatives.

Additional Responsibilities Include:

- Assist in building and nurturing effective, positive working relationships with staff members, board members, and Fredericksburg SPCA volunteers.
- Help to nurture a culture of donor-centered philanthropy within the organization and in all development activities.
- Submit weekly reports to the Director of Development.
- Participate in monthly committee meetings and weekly team calls.

- Strong leadership and organizational skills.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Experience in program development and implementation.

- Self-starter, initiating activities within the framework developed with minimal supervision.
- Ability to work effectively in a team setting and collaborate with different administrative departments.
- Proven experience working with the public, developing and maintaining excellent relationships to support goals/mission.
- Strong computer skills, including a high degree of proficiency in Microsoft Word, Excel, Powerpoint, Google Drive and the ability to maintain accurate records, experience with Salsa databases are a plus!
